

Blue Flax

Linum usitatissimum



This native perennial blooms second and successive seasons from tough, expanding clumps. It is a great early source of nectar for pollinators. Flowers are startling blue on light, airy plants, often closing by midday. Commonly cultivated to make linen and linseed oil.

Full sun to part shade

Dry-medium soil

Up to 60 cm tall (2 ft)

June bloom
