The name compass plant comes from the observation that the leaves have a tendency to orient themselves on a north-south axis. Given the right conditions, plants have been known to live upwards of 100 years! Garden for the future with this bright perennial!

Dry – wet soil, sand - clay

Up to 8 ft tall
