

# Facing Change: A new climate conversation

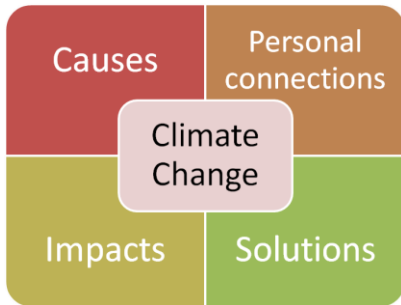
Grades 9 – 12 (75 minutes)

## Small group mind map



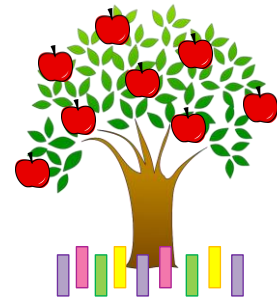
## Climate change haikus
