

# *“Indigenous” Grass*

## *Sorghastrum nutans*



An ornamental grass useful in border plantings intermixed with wildflowers in prairie and meadow gardens. Produces rich gold-purple sprays of flowers and seeds in the fall. Long, flat, narrow blades are dull to dark green. Drought tolerant. This grass is commonly referred to as “Indian” grass but we’ve renamed it to reflect more appropriate terminology.

Full sun to partial shade

3 – 8 ft tall

Dry to moist sand, loam, clay
