

Spotted Joe-Pye Weed

Eutrochium maculatum



Native to damp meadows, thickets and coastal areas in eastern North America. Plants grow on branched, purple-speckled stems clad with serrate, lance-shaped, medium green leaves that typically appear in whorls of 3-6. Tiny, light to deep purple flowers in compound inflorescences bloom from mid-summer to early fall.
