

Anise Hyssop

Agastache foeniculum



This beautiful plant is part of the Mint family. The leaves and flowers emit a licorice odour when crushed and have been used for salads and tea. It produces purple flower spikes atop dark green foliage. A biennial that will self-sow readily.

Full sun to part shade

Dry - medium moisture, sand – clay soil

30 – 90cm tall

July - September bloom
