

# *Blue Lobelia*

## *Lobelia siphilitica*



This showy perennial is usually unbranched but may exhibit some branching. Stems produce lavender-blue, tubular flowers crowded together on the upper stem. This blue counterpart of the Cardinal Flower is a most desirable plant for woodland gardens especially since it blooms bright blue in late summer.

Sun to shade

Moist-wet soils; sand to clay

2-3 ft

August to September

Attracts birds, hummingbirds
