

Canada Wild Rye

Elymus canadensis



A cool season, clump-forming, ornamental bunch grass noted for its arching, wheat/rye-like spikes which bloom in summer and remain attractive well into winter. Foliage and spikes turn tan in fall, but continue to provide visual interest throughout much of the winter.

Full sun

Dry to medium soils

2 to 5 feet

Attracts birds
