E-LEARNING COURSE

Designed to support educators with online learning, *Back to the Tap* aligns with the Ontario Curriculum expectations for CGR4M: Environment Resource Management.

CGR4M explores the complex relationship between human activity and the natural environment, emphasizing the impact of our actions on ecosystems and natural systems. Through this course, students gain a deeper understanding of resource management, sustainability, and their role in environmental stewardship.

Back to the Tap specifically addresses the environmental, social, and economic effects of the bottled water industry. By comparing bottled and tap water, students are encouraged to reflect on their water use, challenge common perceptions, and critically evaluate marketing messages. This course empowers learners to make informed choices and become advocates for sustainable water practices in their communities.

HOW ITS STRUCTURED

Back to the Tap online learning course contains:

- 4 Learning Modules:
 - a. Personal reflection and connection to water
 - b. Environmental impacts of human activities
 - c. Societal and economic impacts
 - d. Community action
- Assignments and worksheets included.

Cost: 250\$ for the academic year, covering two semesters and two implementations.
