

Little Bluestem

Schizachyrium scoparium



Many ornamental grasses make stunning displays when massed on a large scale. This is particularly true when using Little Bluestem. A mass planting will undulate in the breeze.

The fine foliage and distinctive upright flowers pass through an array of colour changes in the autumn after frost. Little Bluestem retires to shades of red or purple and remains showy into winter. Be sure to cut the dried flowers for a winter bouquet. Excessive moisture and fertile soil will cause the tall flower stems to fall over

Dry to medium well-drained soil
