

New England Aster

Symphotrichum novae-angliae



This plant occurs naturally in moist areas and produces clusters of large flowers ranging in colour from pink to deep purple, each with distinct yellow-orange centres. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Full sun or part shade

Medium – moist soil, sand to clay

75-120cm tall

August / September bloom

- ✓ Important fall food source for bees
- ✓ A “top 10” nectar plant for butterflies

Deer resistant
