

# *Virginia Creeper*

## Parthenocissus quinquefolia



Native to eastern North America south to Mexico. This is a vigorous tendril-climbing vine. It needs no support because it clings to surfaces (e.g., brick, stone or wood walls) by adhesive holdfasts (also called sucker disks) located at the tendril ends. It also will creep along the ground as suggested by the common name.

Full sun to part shade

Medium soils

Climbs 30-50 ft or more
