

Homemade Paper Bow

You will need: paper, scissors, glue stick.

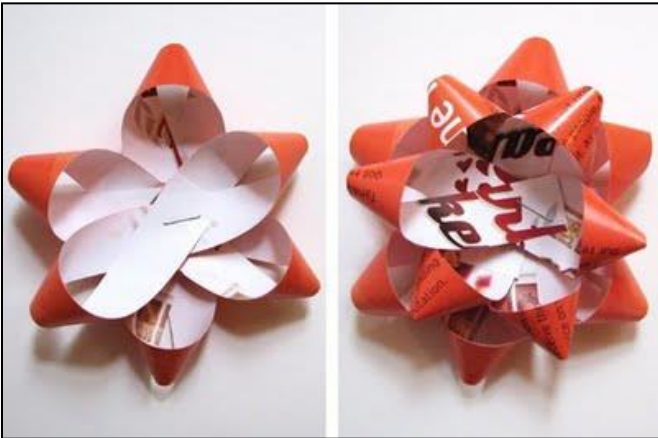
Step 1 - Cut 9 strips of paper (magazine, VHS tape, newspaper, map, etc.), 0.75" wide. Leave 3 strips regular length, cut 1" off 3 of the strips, cut 2" off 2 strips, cut last strip to 3.5" long.



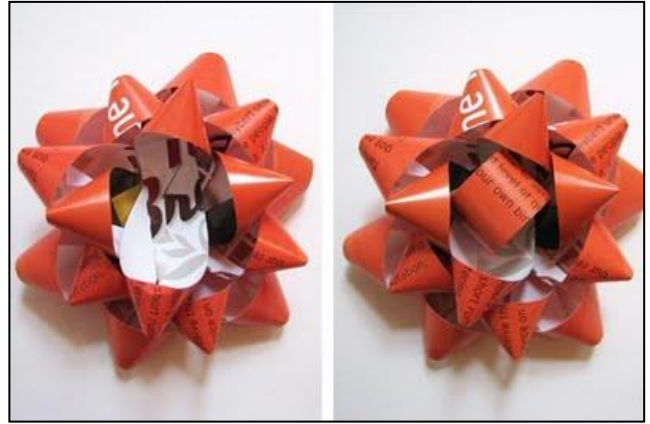
Step 2 - Twist each strip to form a loop at both ends and glue in the centre. Shape the last, short strip into a circle and secure with glue.



Step 3 - Layer the three longest pieces on top of each other, spacing them evenly and securing with glue or a staple.



Step 4 - Add the next 2 groups of pieces, spacing evenly, and securing with glue. Finally, stick the loop in the centre and attach your bow to a gift!
