

Wild Grape Vine

The wild grape vine is truly a vining plant; this means it has no solid, upright trunk. This climbing, multi-stemmed vine can grow so well it can totally envelop bushes and trees. Although the wild grape vine is also known as the riverbank grape, it grows well in locations other than riverbanks. The ripe grape can be eaten but tastes better after the first frost.

Full sun to part shade

Average to moist soils

Climbs to 75 ft
