

# *Common Yarrow*

## Achillea Millefolium



Commonly found along roadsides, fields and disturbed areas, yarrow is a naturalized perennial introduced from Europe and Asia during colonial times. Common yarrow is revered by herbalists – the fragrant, fern-like leaves are a pleasant addition to tisanes and the plant is a “styptic,” meaning it heals wounds and stops bleeding.
